

SILVER STAR AWARD - SELECTION GUIDELINES

The Silver Star Award is the highest county achievement award for Junior 4H'rs. This award will be presented to the most deserving young people without regard to sex. The following are requirements:

1. The member must be at least 12 years of age and no older than 15 as of January 1 of the current year and must have completed at least 2 years in 4-H, including the current year.
2. The 4-H member must submit an awards program record book or an application/nomination for 4-H recognition form and be interviewed by the selection committee at the designated time, in the year they are to be considered for the award.
3. The 4-H member must have completed projects in two different project areas, including submission of appropriate record forms and have participated in one or more activities in at least two of the following areas:
 - Method Demonstrations/4-H Presentation
 - Contests
 - Project Exhibits
 - Camps
 - Leadership Labs
 - Citizenship Activities
 - Public Relations (demonstrations, speeches, poster displays, radio, TV, newspapers, etc.
 - Other (including exchange programs, fund-raising, State & National Congress)

NOTE: It is not expected that the above requirements for projects and activities all be completed in the current year. They may have been accomplished over the entire period of time the 4H'r has been in the program.

The member must have exhibited leadership skills and capabilities, and participated in one or more community service projects (individual, group or club-type) and motivation of other 4-H members through participation in demonstrations, projects and/or exhibits.
