BOUNTY REQUEST FORM

Bounties will ONLY be paid for predators obtained from Kimble County Ranches/Farms that are in good standing and current contributors to the Kimble County Predator Management, Inc. Contributions are requested annually, starting January 1 and ending December 31. If received and approved by the board prior to the new year, the contributor is eligible for bounty payments starting January 1. Contributors that sign up during the year between January 1 and December 31 will become eligible for bounty payments following THIRTY (30) days after their contribution application and funds have been received and approved by the board. Applications are available at the Kimble County Extension Office, or by downloading an application from their website at http://kimble.agrilife.org/publications

By signing this form, landowner/authorized agent/ hunter takes full responsibility for the bounty request and is liable for any false information. If fraud is committed, a LIE DETECTOR test may be administered by the Kimble County Sheriff's Office. Fraud in connection with this bounty program will be punishable under third Degree felony law.

• No payments will be made on road kill, frozen, or decomposed carcasses, for predators obtained outside of Kimble County and/or to non-association members.
• When allocated funds for bounties are exhausted, the bounty program will cease without prior notice, resuming as funds become available.
• No bounty will be paid unless the completed form is submitted with the EARS to the Junction Warehouse Company or West Bear Creek in Kimble County. (Exception for BOBCATS ONLY: a carcass is sufficient to be turned in.) In case of any questionable situation, the Kimble County Predator Management Board will be the deciding authority and the association's decision will be final. The association reserves the right to decline any request.
